Upcoming Important Dates

Monday, January 10th | Emails to volunteers to access eBudde and Digital Cookie will be sent throughout the day. Only volunteers who completed cookie training by Saturday, January 8th will get emails. After this date, emails will be sent every other day once training is complete.

Tuesday, January 11th 6:30 pm | Cookie Rookie Series – Initial Order and Inventory Management. This virtual training will help troops plan their initial cookie order and how to manage their cookie inventory. Another session is available on **Saturday**, **January, 15th at 10 am**. Important Updates

We know the Girl Scouting community is small and with social media news travels fast, so some of you might hear from friends and family about a possible shortage of Adventurefuls (the new Girl Scout cookie) due to supply chain issues. Our bakery, Little Brownie, informed us that Adventurefuls will be available at our initial order time but reorders from the bakery may be limited. In the coming days, we will meet with our contacts at Little Brownie for information specific to our council. We will share any updates during our weekly emails. At this time, this only effects Adventurefuls and all other cookies are not affected in this supply chain issue.
