IN-PERSON EVENT PLANNING

SETUP & CONSIDERATIONS

An in-person rally is a tried-and-true way to get girls pumped for the Girl Scout Cookie Season. Here are a few items to consider when choosing to meet in person:

Girl Scout Only or a Family Event:

Cookie Rallies can be either a Girl Scout only event or family event. With a family event, Caregivers can learn ways to support their Girl Scout during the cookie program. This will determine if you want to focus on the Family Cookie Entrepreneur Family Pins or the Cookie Badges (both new or old depending on your troop) or activities for a fun patch or all three!

Facilitators:

Girl Scouts® Cookie Captains make great rally leaders. They can run stations or offer cookie season knowledge. These can be Juniors Girl Scouts and up.

Troop Meeting or Special Event

Your cookie rally can be during a regular troop meeting or a special time.


SAMPLE AGENDA

- 1. **Set-Up 1 to 2 Hours**
 - a. Prepare materials and create examples
 - b. Set-Up Activity Stations
- 2. Welcome and Check In 10 minutes
 - a. Check Girl Scouts in for attendance
 - b. Provide name tags or welcome activity
 - c. Welcome Girl Scouts with high energy and excitement.
 - d. Provide directions about station rotation or time amounts at each station.
- 3. Stations 10 20 minutes per station
 - a. Rotate thought stations
 - i. Business Ethics
 - ii. People Skills
 - iii. Goal Setting
 - iv. Decision Making
 - v. Money Management
- 4. Wrap-Up 10 minutes
 - a. Thank everyone for coming
 - b. Patches

ACTIVITIES

Supplies:

- scissors
- tape or glue
- key tags

ADVENTUREFULS™ SWAP

Swap out last season's booth wearables with an Adventurefuls-inspired charm.

Girls decorate key tags to look like the new Girl Scout Cookie™ and turn them into SWAPs, pins or necklaces — all while learning about the delicious ingredients.

KOALA-TY FRIENDS

Say hello to the Girl Scout Cookie™ mascot from Down Under!

Introduce girls to their cuddly new friend by engaging them in a mascotinspired craft and teaching koala fun facts. But first, have girls take a quiz together to see how much they know about their new friend!

Supplies:

- paper plates
- markers or crayons (gray & black)
- scissors
- tape or glue
- cotton balls
- string
- stapler
- hole punch

KOALA POUCH PLATE

Teach girls about koalas and joeys with this simple paper plate craft.

Using paper plates and markers, girls can make a baby koala and tuck it into the mother's pouch.



VIRTUAL GROUP ACTIVITIES




Seek and find:

FEARLESS GOAL-GETTERS

Setting a goal is an important — and exciting! — part of the Girl Scout Cookie Season.

Teach girls all about different types of goals. Then inspire them to set a Girl Scout Cookie™ goal and work toward achieving it with a goal tracker activity.

Supplies:

- cardstock
- pipe cleaners
- scissors
- clip art
- hole punch
- tape or glue stick
- markers
- template & clip art


Optional: Bring the outside indoors by using a branch or twig instead of a pipe cleaner.

THE GOAL TREE

Inspire girls to keep climbing throughout the season by offering this mascot-inspired goal tracker.

They can fill in package goals, attach images of rewards they want to earn, or write what they want to do with their cookie earnings.

GIRL SCOUT COOKIE INGENUITY

Cookie entrepreneurs are always coming up with fresh new ways to market Girl Scout Cookies.®

Try out this booth marketing activity or encourage girls to brainstorm their own ideas.

Supplies:

- 22"x28" poster board
- tape or glue
- scissors
- markers
- template & clip art

Optional: Give the troop's Girl Scout Cookie™ menu board a little extra pizazz by using stickers and other decorations.

GIRL SCOUT COOKIET MENU BOARD

Girls can create cookie menu boards and customize them with their goals and Girl Scouts[®] Hometown Hero organization.

Feature the menu board by taping to a table, placing in a picture frame or attaching to a sandwich board.

Customers love to see girls' goals on display!





SAFETY SMARTS

Girl safety is always the number one priority.

Review Girl Scouts' safety guidelines with girls, then turn the learning into a fun game!

Supplies:

- bingo call sheet and cards
- markers

Optional: prizes for winners

SAFETY BINGO

Girls will tune into these tips when they play Girl Scout Cookie™ safety bingo at the rally.

Whether you play all at once in large groups or play as girls go through stations, it's a fun way to promote safety smarts.











MARKETING

Supplies:

- wooden craft sticks
- tape or glue
- scissors
- template
- backdrop (i.e., a solidcolored blanket, blank wall or even a green screen)

DIGITAL COOKIE® PHOTO BOOTH

Say, 'cookies!' Set up a booth to take photos and videos for business pages on Digital Cookie.

Provide photo props featuring Girl Scout Cookies, goals or marketing messages. Girls can even make DIY props out of empty cookie packages!

Top Tip

Before they enter the booth, ask them to write down their top online marketing strategies. Then turn the tips into a word cloud and share back with girls after the rally.

Ask a Girl Scouts® Cookie Captain to lead a session on how to optimize their Digital Cookie sites and how to use social media to market to customers.

Photo props promote the new cookie!

PITCH PRACTICE


Supplies:
