Getting Your Troop Started for the 2021 Fall Product Program

Here are the steps for getting your troop started in the GSNMT MagNut Program. MagNut is our council's simple way of say Magazines and Nuts and those are the items Girl Scouts sell during the Fall Product Program along with candy.

Step 1: Complete the 2021 Troop Fall Product Program Chair Agreement:

Troop MagNut Chairs need to complete their Troop Chair Agreement form online at:

https://forms.gle/FbLH3L8dvLYzGeKq7

This lets us know who to give access to the 2021 Fall Product Program Training for Troop Chairs in gsLearn (our online training system).

Step 2: Complete Trainings on gsLearn

The training will be available on Monday, August 23rd at 5 pm. If you complete the Troop Chair Agreement by noon on Monday, August 23rd you will have access to the training when it goes live. You will be notified via email when the training is available. Volunteers who submit their form after August 23rd will gain access to the training within 24 hours of completing form and can check the gsLearn system for their training. gsLearn is now mobile friendly!

Step 3: Check Email

24 hours after completing training you will receive an email from GSNMT regarding picking-up materials, next steps, and Service Unit specific information.

Step 4: Attend a MagNut Q&A Session

If you have questions after completing the training or need additional assistance, you can attend a virtual Troop MagNut Q&A Session with the GSNMT Product Program Manager on Zoom. Dates for sessions will be provided in the training and follow-up email. The session is optional but highly recommended.

Important Dates

- **September 14**th: Deadline to complete training and families to complete Product Permission Forms to ensure troop can begin on the 1st day of the Fall Product Program
- September 24th: Program begins online ordering opens and girls may take orders in-person
- October 17th: Last day to take orders on the paper order card
- October 21st: Last day for online girl delivery orders
- November 7th: Last day for online orders for magazines and shipped nut and chocolate orders
- Week of November 8th: Nut and chocolate items will be delivered to Service Unit sites
