- IN NEW MEXICO YOU NEED 50 HOURS OF SUPERVISED DRIVING EXPERIENCE WITH AN ADULT TO OBTAIN A DRIVER LICENSE.
- COSMOTOLOGISTS MUST COMPLETE 1600 HOURS UNDER SUPERVISION TO BE LICENSED IN NEW MEXICO!
- TEEN DRIVERS ARE AT HIGHEST RISK FOR CAR CRASHES. THE CRASH RATE (PER MILE DRIVEN) FOR 16 YEAR OLDS IS FOUR TIMES THAT OF ADULT DRIVERS.
- HAVING PASSENGERS IS A SERIOUS DISTRACTION FOR TEEN DRIVERS. CARRYING THREE OR MORE PASSENGERS INCREASES THE RISK OF A CRASH FOR 16 AND 17 YEAR OLDS THREE-FOLD COMPARED TO DRIVING ALONE.
