Step 1 - • Read Clover's Story • Talk about Clover's Story

**Step 2** – Make a collage using old magazines or postcards • Using resources you have around the house, make a collage to represent how you use your resources wisely. This could be old magazines, old postcards, old calendar pictures, pieces of scrap art supplies, etc.

**Step 3** – Practice being resourceful • Practice recycling something into something else that you can use again. Take a plastic cup, soup can, coffee can, Pringles can, something that you have already used. Clean it up and make it into something else. It could become a planter with some dirt, seeds, and water. It could become a pencil holder. Whatever you make it into, make sure to decorate up the outside with materials from around your home.



## **Helpful Tips for Using Resources Wisely**

- With scissors and a shirt you can recycle or upcycle it into a bag.
- Please keep clothes out of landfills.
- Give old clothes new life by making easy repairs and making clothes reusable when donated. If clothes cannot be repaired, please recycle clothes.
- Torn and stained clothing can be made into rags, stuffing, and insulation. Local nonprofits may accept donations for recycling as large amounts of textiles can help the organization.
- Make a sit upon from old vinyl tablecloths and newspapers. Sew or use duct tape to close.
- Make recycled paper.
- Make <u>upcycled ornaments</u> or other recycled art projects.
