
well.

HOW TO REGISTER

Visit nmgirlscouts.org, hover over "Discover" then click on the "Event Calendar" link to open the GSNMT Calendar. Navigate to your program of choice by clicking "View Details". Once there, click "Register Now".

Your Girl Scout will not be guaranteed a spot in a program until you have completed the payment process. Spots sitting in the shopping cart are not saved spots. Upon completion, you will receive a confirmation email. This email contains important information such as links, required materials, and event details. If vou do not receive a confirmation email, contact customercare@ nmgirlscouts.org.

A limited number of adult spaces are available at all events. Our goal is to accommodate as many Girl Scouts at these events as possible. GSNMT reserves the right to cancel and refund additional adults not required for Safety Wise ratio.
