As part of the agreement, exemplary Girl Scouts who have earned a Gold, Silver, or Bronze Award; been referred to Hiram by their troop leader as a strong match for Hiram College; and have been admitted to the College will be awarded a substantial Hiram College Scholarship. The Girl Scout Gold Award Scholarship is worth 62 percent of tuition and mandatory fees in the traditional college program for the 2019-20 academic year. The Girl Scout Bronze-Silver Award Scholarship is worth 50 percent of tuition and mandatory fees in the traditional college program for the 2019-20 academic year.

To qualify for one of these scholarships, students must:

- be admitted to Hiram College
- have a High School GPA of 2.8 or above
- have an ACT score of 18 or higher

To **retain** one of these scholarships, students must:

- maintain a 2.0 College GPA
- remain active and in good standing at the College

This award cannot be combined with other Hiram merit-based awards. If a recipient should qualify for a merit-based scholarship at Hiram, the student will be awarded the scholarship of highest value for the 2019-20 academic year.
